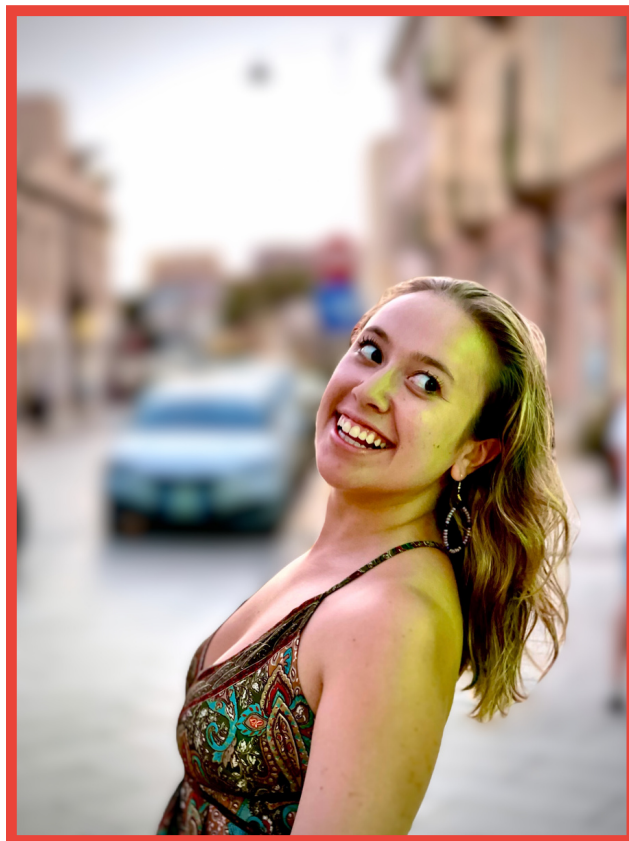


Lucy Taylor

In 2017, Lucy accepted a bid into the most sought-after sorority at the University of Maryland. This decision would alter the trajectory of her college life. In her short time there, she experienced slut shaming, rape, and cyber-bullying. Three years after her traumatic exit from the sorority, she released SNAPPED, a podcast that highlights the strategic manipulation and cult-like environment that members of sororities and fraternities endure. Lucy aims to spread her message of resilience to audiences across North America and help others gain control over their traumatic narratives. Lucy empowers her audiences to trust their gut instincts and equips them with the knowledge that they have the right to feel safe on their college campus.



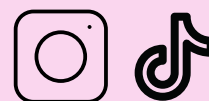
